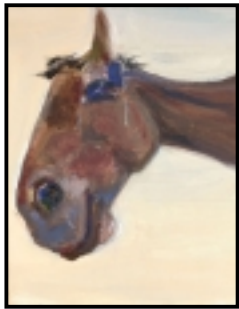

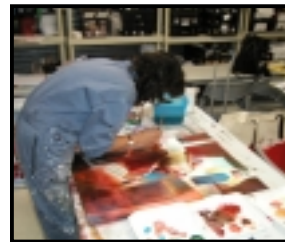
A Survey of Recent Works

This year's Artist in Residence 2010 is Shelley Parriott. Her exhibition, titled *Color Field Sculpture* in the Plein Air Gallery, consists of colorful perforated steel sculptures, that have the appearance of mesh or sheer fabric. The sculptures will reflect in the Museum's pond and will provide a striking contrast to the water and tropical landscape. The Museum will also be partnering with five high schools whose art students will assist with the installation and deinstallation of the Plein Air Gallery.
